RESISTENZA traces the stories of men and women who managed to escape from Argentina after the military coup d'état in 1976 and made their way to Rome, where they were received with warmth by the Italian people, but disregarded by the government who refused to grant them the status of political refugees.

Artisans, workers, intellectuals, psychoanalysts, musicians, and poets played the lead role in heroic actions forged from what little resources they had. They gradually began to achieve their objective of gaining visibility for the tragedy that was taking place in Argentina.

In the present, a group of young Argentines and Italians organize activities in Rome and carry on with active resistance. Through music and murga, with traditional asados and gatherings in the city, together they establish continuity in the struggle against the worldwide advance of the right.


